Dear Sir:

In response to your letter of November 28, 2005 obviously our letters crossed in the mail. As stated in my last letter the response from the Canadian Judicial Council was exactly what I had expected, **no** response to my request for investigation and review.

This is comparable to my previous experiences with O.C.C.O.P. for our Police Law Enforcement and the Environmental Review Tribunal which like your own entity are government patronage appointed entities represented as providing recourse for problems of the people for review in the public interest, when in fact all of these entities in our experience serve no useful purpose whatsoever but to slam the door shut on a particular incident or problem and hope that that is the end of it and the problem will go away.

It is undisputed that there was flagrant errors in law in Justice Cavarzans decision which our lawyers clearly identified to the Appeals Court Justices who proceeded to ignore this evidence.

In review we have lost Appeal Book Transcripts with **no** review or reference by the Appeals Justices of the evidence provided at trial as contained in the Appeal Book Transcripts **prior** to hearing the appeal, which is in fact contrary to court procedure, and in addition proceeded to hear our appeal in a court without Jurisdiction all of which was clearly and without question an **abuse of process** by Justices Keenan, Somers and Cumming JJ who knowingly supported in their decision the misapplication and errors in law of Justice Cavarzan.

All of these Justices are paid with public funds to properly administer the law in the public interest. When this responsibility is **not** fulfilled, how can **manipulation** and **misapplication** of the law **not** be defined as **misconduct**?

We suggest that the Canadian Judicial Council should further review and reconsider this matter and proceed with appropriate action.

Please find enclosed a picture of the sign displayed in the December 14, 2005 Landowners protest on 401 Highway Ingersol, Ontario. Also find a picture of the sign to be displayed at all future Landowner protest events. We further advise that our website will be advertised in the next issue of the "Landowner". President of the Ontario Landowners Association Randy Hillier has indicated an interest in publishing our story in future articles of the "Landowner".

We are completely fed up with these slippery manipulations promoted through the Ontario Ministry of the Attorney General and the Crown Law Office and must advise that we shall proceed as stated in this and our previous letters, and if in fact these outstanding issues are not addressed in the very near future, we shall arrange to have the story of these government manipulated politically correct law corrupted events inflicted upon our company and this family published in book form and distributed throughout North America. The written word never dies.

This is not the end of this story, but the beginning of the end of this story.
