
This letter in response to your letter of Oct. 18, 1999 advising me to contact Ms. Cathy Hiuser Manager Court Operations to arrange for reproductions of the 15 books of lost transcripts And further that Ms Hiuser would be responding to my inquiry regarding clarification for The cancellation of our February 1999 court date by "Darren". letter enclosed.

At this point we have received no response from Ms. Hiuser, and subject to the recent dismissal Of our leave to Appeal Nov. 24, 1999. I hereby request the Immediate reproduction of our lost Transcripts due to the following courses of action under consideration:

1. A request to the Federal Justice Minister for a Judicial Inquiry into the decisions of Justice Cavarzan, Cumming, Keenan and Somers.
2. A filing for Leave to Appeal to the Supreme Court of Canada.
3. A filing of Criminal charges for Conspiracy, Perjury, falsified government documents, involving officials of Delhi Township, The Ministry of Transportation, three OPP officers and two Provincial Crown Attorneys.
4. In the event of dismissal of our leave to Appeal, a filing for total losses and costs sustained in the Delhi Township case against Lawyers Paul Arney, Peter Haney and Paul Brooks and the Ontario Court of Justice for the negligent actions which resulted in our appeal being heard in The wrong court, deferral of court date, the lost transcripts, and the Appeal Court Justices Hearing and ruling on our case without even having received or read the transcripts of evidence For the appeal that they were appointed to hear.

In respect to the fact that our last date for filing for Leave to Appeal would be Jan 24, 2000, in Order to avoid a repeat performance of the fiasco that we have just been subjected to, I would Suggest that the deadline for reproduction of the transcripts should be the last date for filing Leave to Appeal, so that in the event that one or more of the Supreme Court Justices have An interest in the administration of Justice, these transcripts can be made available for review.

I thank you for your co-operation in this regard.
