Dear Sir:

On April 24, 2007 I wrote to the Law Society of Upper Canada to request that they investigate the performance of Lawyers Dennis Brown, Nicholas Adamson and Connie Vernon in respect to the production of an Application for Court Injunction which was granted by the Court November 7, 2006 to prevent the operation of Nichols Gravel Limited Hagersville Quarry.

We find and have confirmed this application to be a negligent misrepresentation and a complete fraud to both Nichols Gravel Limited, its Officers and the Court as conspired by the M.N.R. and the Crown Law Office.

For that reason as well as for the extended harassment by M.N.R. to the enforcement over the past 4 years of these illegally imposed falsified documents to Pre Operating Conditions, not found on any other licence, we hereby request that you direct an immediate investigation for possible criminal charges to the production of falsified documents and the enforcement by staff of the Ministry of Natural Resources.

David Ramsay all based upon enforcement of "23 Specific Pre Operating Conditions" imposed upon Licence 103717.

Secondly an investigation of M.N.R. and Crown Law Office lawyers who have continued right up to the present to promote and defend this extended fraud upon our company under charges pending before the Court, namely Demetrius Kappos, Nicholas Adamson, Connie Vernon and Dennis Brown.

This request to investigate has been further provoked by the fact that Brant M.P.P. David LeVac on May 17, 2007 made a commitment to contact Minister Ramsay in an attempt to get this matter resolved. Now Mr. LeVac is also not responding.

At this point in time, 3 different Court Decisions have ruled and confirmed that "Pre Operating Conditions" do not form part of Licence 103717. End of story.


