Dear Stephen:

Please find enclosed a copy of my letter of request to the Canadian Judicial Council for a Judicial Inquiry into the various court decisions to dismiss our litigation with Delhi Township which concluded with the decision of the Supreme Court of Canada September 28, 2000.

The reason I have made this request is that this manipulated corrupted decision of Justice Cavarzan continues to be promoted as providing justice, when in fact it provided obstruction of justice.

There are 2 other lawsuits before the courts filed by our company, one to the Region of Haldimand-Norfolk for which we are proceeding for a court date, and one to Norfolk Township which is now into Discoveries.

We find at this point that the lawyer for the Crown Law Office of Ontario under the Ministry of the Attorney General representing the Ministry of Transportation and the Lawyer for the Frank Cowan Ins. Co. representing the municipalities has now under consideration, to file a motion for dismissal to the courts on the grounds that both of these cases are comparable to the Delhi case dismissed by Justice Cavarzan. There point being that the court has previously made a ruling, and therefore it cannot be brought before the court again.

Should this succeed at court, this would in fact be the ultimate injustice, to have our other 2 court actions deferred by the courts based on this law perverted decision of Justice Cavarzan.

I have provided this request for inquiry to our Member of Parliament office for Dianne Finely and at that time had a brief discussion with John, whereby I requested Dianne's support to my request for inquiry by way of a brief letter to the Canadian Judicial Council.

I am also requesting the same from yourself, as I believe this would be most helpful.

Dear Sir:

Now, ten years after receiving a speculative, biased and prejudiced decision of dismissal from Supreme Court Justice John Carvarzan in respect to the case of Nichols Gravel Limited v. the Township of Delhi, David Anderson, Frank Gelinis this business and this family continues to search for some degree of justice from our justice system.

This horrific horror story and decision was transferred from the Ontario Court of Appeal to Divisional Court, a court that we later learned had no jurisdiction to hear the appeal, and was heard on June 3, 1999 by Justices Keenan, Somers and Cumming J.J. without reference to the transcripts of evidence from the trial which the Justices stated they did not receive. The court later confirmed that \$3500.00 worth of our transcripts had been lost. The appeals Justices received our lawyer's presentation, did not request the defence to speak, took a short recess and came back and dismissed our appeal quoting the errors in law of Justice Carvarzan word for word. To this point in my opinion both of these decisions were misapplication and manipulation of law, and in that respect gross negligent misconduct by all of these Justices.

In the interim appeal period, we had identified and confirmed that false evidence and forged documents had been provided by Mr. Anderson and Mr. Gelinis at trial and had requested Police investigations and that criminal charges be laid. Crown Attorney L. Aicken and Senior Cr. J. Ayre of Simcoe refused to file criminal charges, as did Crown Attorney Swanson of Brantford who shortly thereafter accepted a government package and retired at age 54. This allowed our appeals to spin through the Courts to final dismissal at the Supreme Court of Canada "without" consideration and without "reasons".

On October 7, 2005 a request for Judicial Inquiry was made to the Canadian Judicial Council to investigate the negligent misconduct related to the misapplication of law related to these decisions of dismissal.

Obviously in this short time period again there was no investigation.

Also see my letter of response dated November 30, 2005. Because there evolved a conspiracy by officials of 3 municipal Corporations to shut our companies out of the competition in order to bankrupt our companies, additional lawsuits were filed against the former Region of Haldimand-Norfolk, and Norfolk Township. At this point lawyer Murray Stieber acting on behalf of Norfolk Township has brought a motion before the courts for dismissal claiming that the case of Delhi Township which was dismissed in its entirety by Justice Carvarzan is identical, and therefore cannot be tried again.

This is in fact the motivation for our request to you to exercise your authority as Attorney General to direct the Canadian Judicial Court to investigate and take appropriate action concerning the misconduct of these various Justices. To allow the Courts to dismiss another claim which is similar but not identical based on such fraudulent previous decisions would be the ultimate pinnacle of injustice of our Justice system.

I further request that you direct the Royal Canadian Mounted Police to investigate the conspiracy to bankrupt our company, and the contraventions of Section 45 of the Combines Act as it relates to restriction of competition and misappropriation of Public Funds as a result of the numerous illegal interferences to business relations of Nichols Gravel Limited since 1994 to the present.
