Our company a member of the Norfolk, Oxford and Elgin Landowners Association was represented and attended along with other Landowner Chapters across the Province at Queen's Park on December 6, 2007 in support of past Ontario Landowner's Association president and newly elected M.P.P. Randy Hillier who addressed the legislature on behalf the landowners and described some of the problems experienced between landowners and government and in particular mentioned the shut down by M.N.R. of the Quarry business of Nichols Gravel at Hagersville, Ontario.

On December 10, 2007 Nichols Gravel Limited provided 2 large dump trucks to the Tobacco train protest from Delhi to Six Nations in support of Tobacco Landowner's impacted by government policies which have devastated this industry and also impacted our business which started with the tobacco industry in 1943 at Delhi, Ontario.

Should government continue to decline to address these problems, we contemplate a huge all Ontario Landowner's protest coordinated with a dump truck protest by Nichols Gravel Limited at Queen's Park when the legislature reconvenes in March 2008.
