Dear Sir:

I am in receipt of your letter of January 20, 2015, to which I respond as follows, as the Manager of Nichols Gravel Limited:

First, it would appear that you have been misinformed as to the status of this property and the unlawfully Revoked Licence, through the fabrication of the falsified direction to compliance to, "23 Specific Pre Operational Conditions" as directed to MNR enforcement in the March 31, 2003 letter **NOT** directed as "Pre Operational Conditions" in Final OMB Order 1194, or Licence 103717, as signed by the Minister, March 25, 2003.

The charges to prosecution to which you refer which were rendered by J.P. Bonas and Appealed to Judge D. A. Harris for Dismissal, are now before The Justice Of The Peace Council and the Ontario Judicial Council for Investigation for numerous errors in Law, bias and infringement of Charter Rights due to the fact that through the manipulations by the Crown, we were denied Appeal of the Judge Harris Decision.

Further to that, there are additional MNR charges before the Courts (same charges) due to be heard on Appeal, March 25, 2015. In that respect, it would be premature for any intervention by TOARC in the legal process which could attract Trespass Charges or an Injunction Order to Cease and Desist.

I further suggest that TOARC and MNR have no Jurisdictional Authority to interfere with OMB Order 1194, as it relates to the zoning uses ordered and approved for this property, as it relates to a Redi-Mix Concrete Plant, which we may or may not proceed with at this location at our own discretion.

In closing, I suggest that at this point TOARC should defer from any specific action concerning this property, and avoid becoming involved in this unlawful vexatious enforcement to this property and our Company as confirmed by the June 15, 2006, Superior Court Judicial Review, Declaratory Orders, 1, 2, and 3, **not** Appealed.
